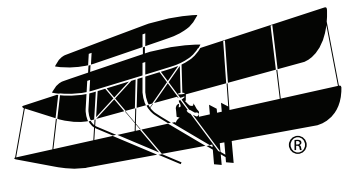

See a cannon, pewter plate, gold flakes and other items recovered from Blackbeard's shipwreck *Queen Anne's Revenge*. The shipwreck was discovered at Beaufort Inlet in 1996. And be sure to check out the interactive trunk (i.e., treasure chest) to find out what pirates really treasured. Was it really gold, silver and jewels?
