Camp Rockmont is 220 miles from Raleigh.

Destination: French Broad River and **WATER, SUN AND FUN !!!!!**
The French Broad is a class 2/3 river. Over 12,000 Trail Mates/Blazers have safely rafted the river.

Included: Breakfast, Lunch on the river, Full day of rafting with your tribe, Transportation to river & back to camp by bus (1-hour trip each way) and permission to be at camp on Thursday night.
Rafting Vendor is Blue Heron Whitewater. Bus Vendor is Young Transportation.

The annual rafting trip is organized and run by volunteers to assist the Program Office and to keep the cost at a minimum. All money collected is paid to the various vendors that are used to supply housing, food, buses, mailings, and rafting. No money is left over, and no compensation is given to the volunteers to arrange the trip. Our vendors require 30 days advance notice to make their commitments for supplying our services. This advance notice and payment is the reason we have had a no refund policy each year.

The trip is an optional add-on to the Fall Outing Weekend. Attendance at the Fall Outing is a requirement for rafting. The French Broad River is a class 2/3 river. We have safely and successfully rafted 4th grade and up Trail Mates/Blazers for twenty years. The trip is held every year on Friday so that the Fall Outing can be enjoyed in its entirety. Participants must be at camp Thursday night, which requires young blazers and mates to miss school on Friday. We, along with our previous 12,000+ participants, believe the experience with Dad enriches our youth and more than makes up for the missed day of school. We understand that many of you cannot miss school and hope to see you at the Fall Outing on Saturday and Sunday.

If you are not rafting with us on Friday, you cannot stay at camp Thursday Night.
